Preventive, Primary & Behavioral Healthcare Coordination

Screening, Brief Intervention, Referral and Treatment (SBIRT) Program: Co-Location of Behavioral Health Services In Prenatal Care

A multi-disciplinary evidence-based SBIRT approach to promote optimal behavioral health of pregnant women to reduce the harmful effects of substance use, depression and domestic violence and improve birth outcomes.

Wellness Services

Health education, tobacco cessation groups, nutrition classes, and physical fitness activities for CAHS clients.

Nurse Family Partnership

Evidence-based community health program providing home visitation services to first time mothers who are less than 28 weeks pregnant and their families through the child's second birthday.

Post-Incarceration Service Coordination

Coordination of screening and discharge planning to assure timely access to services upon release/reentry into the community.

Emergency and Disaster Preparedness

Coordination and response services for people with behavioral health needs, developmental disabilities and the broader community to expedite attaining a safe environment and assist in recovery from emergencies/disasters.

Behavioral Health Emergency Services Continuum

A coordinated comprehensive community-based system to avoid repeated cycles of crises and to support stability.

FEES: Medicaid, Medicare, and most major private insurances are accepted. Insurance copays, deductibles, and coinsurance due at the time of service unless acceptable payment arrangements are made. Please call our billing office at 225-922-0838 for service coverage and benefits for private insurance. Fees are assessed for uninsured clients requesting services based on his/her ability to pay. The sliding fee schedule is based on family income and total number of individuals in the household who are dependent on that income.

CONFIDENTIALITY is protected by federal and state laws. Employees are prohibited from sharing any information about clients with anyone outside of this agency, except as required by law.
