Are you struggling with the use of heroin or pain pills?

HELP IS HERE:

If you have a history of dependence or abuse of heroin, pain killers, Suboxone, or methadone, you may benefit from learning more about medication methods to reduce cravings and to prevent relapse.

Capital Area Human Services (CAHS) offers screening, assessments, treatment, and referrals. We support our clients through individualized treatment approaches that may include medical treatment options as part of relapse prevention.

Your treatment plan may include the medication Vivitrol, as a best practice, due to its high rate of success in relapse prevention. It is delivered to you as a monthly injection and as part of your overall treatment plan that includes group and individualized services. Vivitrol will be prescribed based on your treatment plan and your ability to acquire it.

BENEFITS OF VIVITROL:

- Blocks the effects of opioids
- Approved by the FDA to treat opioid use disorders
- Administered as an injectable given monthly
- Recent research indicates effectiveness equal to Suboxone

MEDICATION COST: CAHS does not cover the cost for this medication. However, you may qualify for the medication as part of the Vivitrol Patient Assistance Program. Your insurance pharmacy benefit plans may cover the cost of Vivitrol. If you have commercial non-governmental insurance, you may also qualify for Vivitrol's Co-pay Savings Program.

FEES: Medicaid, Medicare, and most major private insurances are accepted. Insurance co-pays, deductibles, and coinsurance are due at the time of service unless acceptable payment arrangements are made. Fees are assessed for uninsured clients requesting services based on their ability to pay. The sliding fee schedule is based on family income and total number of individuals in the household who are dependent on that income.
